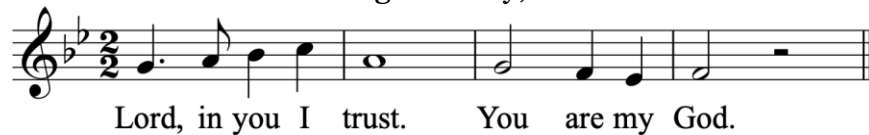

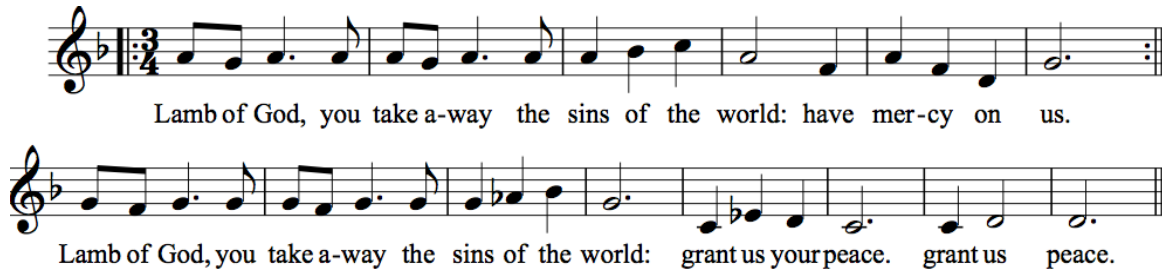

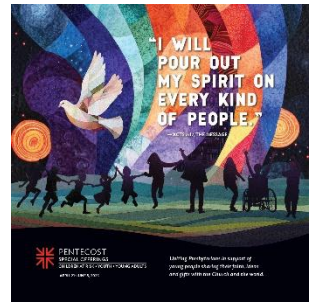


Donations
