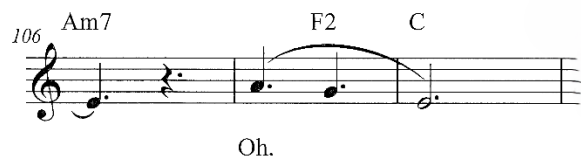
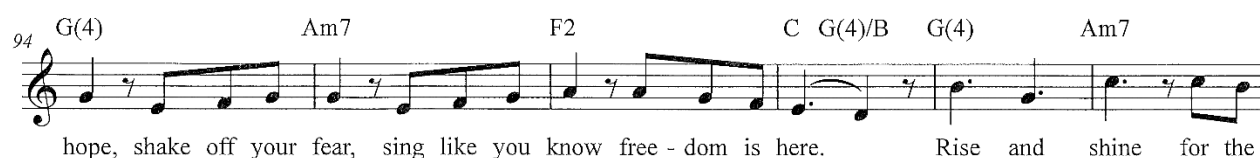
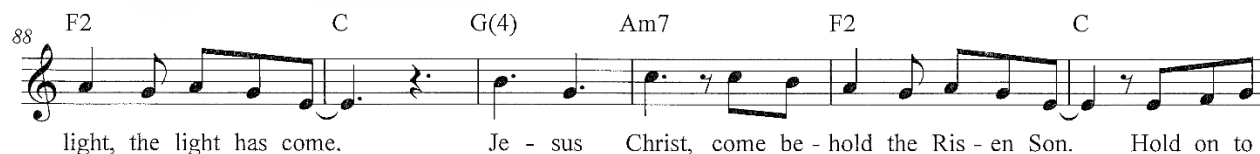

Author and Presenter Arthur M. Bohanan will take you on a journey through his book

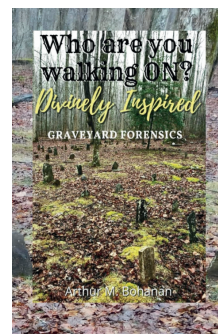
WHO ARE YOU WALKING ON?

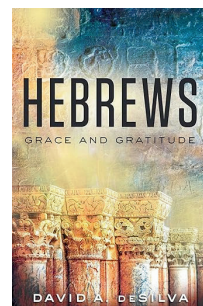
This Sunday, we will begin a focus on gratitude by studying the book Hebrews: Grace and Gratitude.

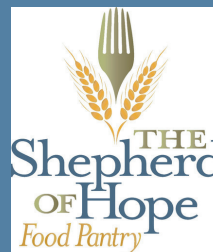
